- Change the tree slide to include housing types other than bungalows

GENERAL COMMENTS

- Community members concerns revolve around density issues
- Mature trees
- Create a design look book – to help applicants build houses that fit better into the character

SECOND QUESTION:

When you think about residential infill, what is going well? (this transitions to medium and high discussion)

- Be sure to include concrete definitions of medium and high density

THIRD QUESTION:

When you think about residential infill, what could be improved on?

FOURTH QUESTION:

What conditions or elements support successful infill in Edmonton?

- This one may be too technical eg. What needs to happen to support...?
- Eg. What is your definition of successful infill?
- Eg. how do make Edmonton a leader in infill in Canada?, get people thinking beyond the city limits
